


Accessing eLearning Training

Students desiring to take online courses at Wallace Community College must complete eLearning Training prior to registering for an online course. The eLearning Training program provides students the foundation of technical skills and study skills necessary to succeed in the online course environment.

1. Go to the Wallace Community College Website at www.wallace.edu
2. Choose **Blackboard** from the options at the top of the page.
3. Students login with their student number as their Username and their date of birth in mmddyy format for their Password.
 - a. Students will receive access to Blackboard within 24 hours of admission to the College.
 - b. Students and guests may preview eLearning Training by using the Preview as Guest option. Students should not complete tests or assignments until they are able to login using their student number.
