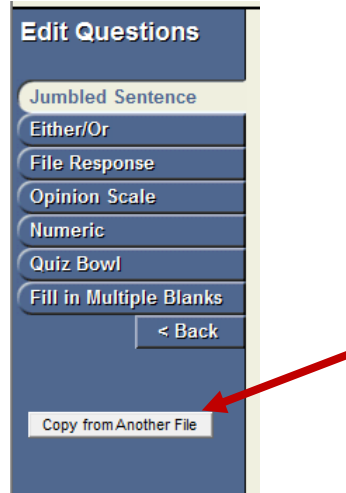
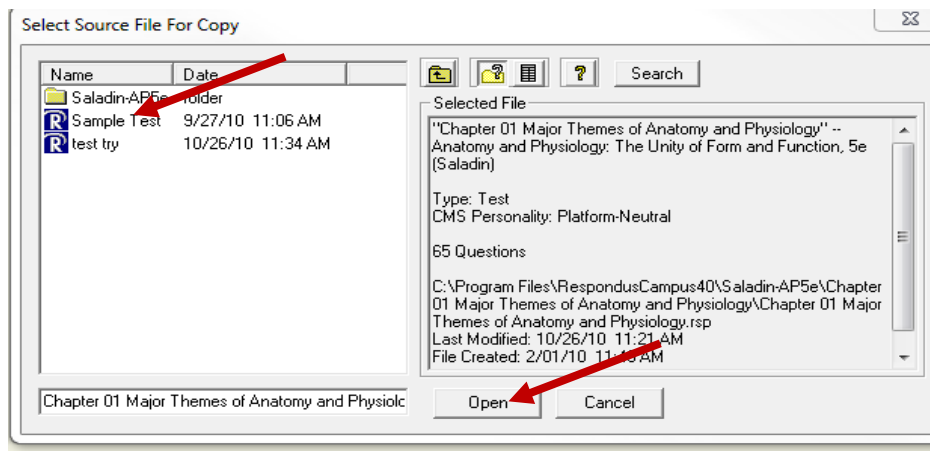

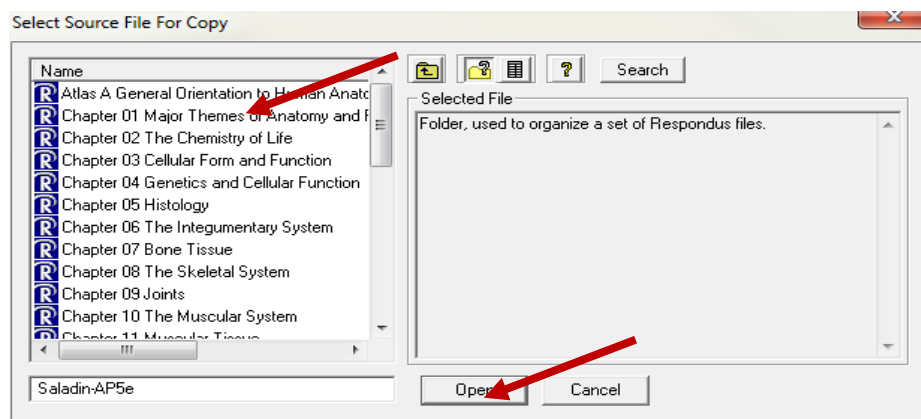
1. After opening Respondus, click <Copy from another File>.

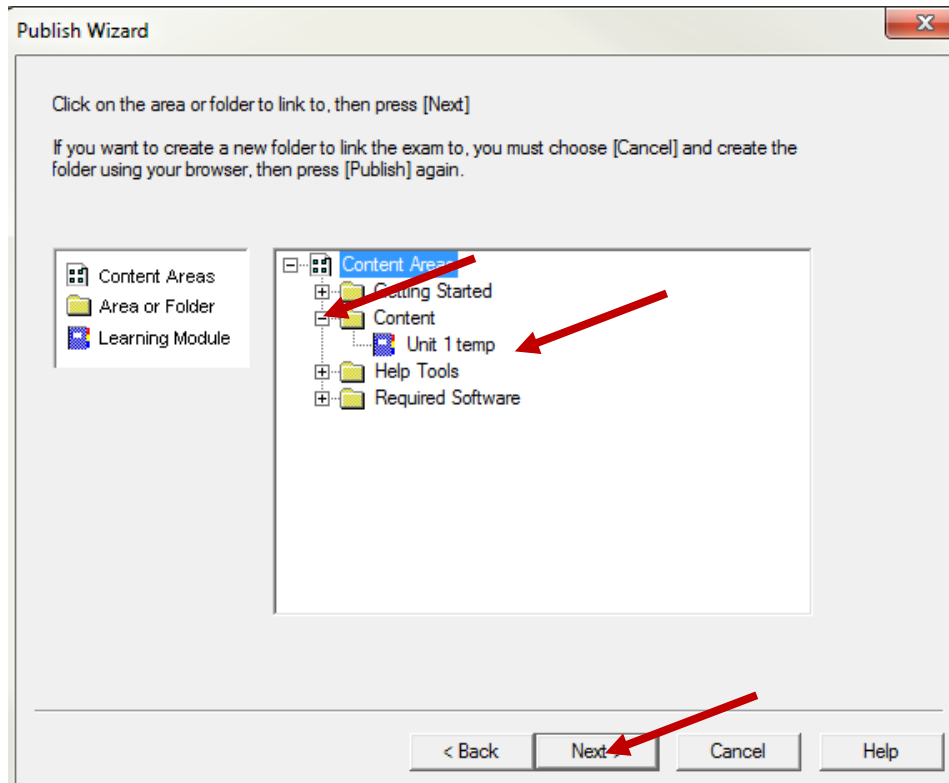
